

Speaker: *Jonathan Parnell* from Christ Covenant Reformed Presbyterian Church, Lawrence, KS will speak on *"Conflict in the Church...Sowing Peace."*

Coordinated classes for all ages and a Nursery are provided. Afternoons are free for recreation and/or relaxation. Special activities are planned for each evening and the days will be concluded around a campfire.

Afternoon activities include swimming, canoeing, nature walks, basketball, volleyball, tennis, softball, bouldering wall, frisbee golf, and water slide. Playground equipment is located near the Pavilion and Lodge.

Check-In and registration for the camp will begin at 4:00 P.M. on Sunday, July 29th. Supper will be at 5:30 P.M. followed by an evening worship service. The camp will end on Thursday, August 2nd at 1:00 P.M.

Day Fees: There is a \$15 day fee for visitors who stay for two meals and classes and/or activities. A \$10 half day fee is charged for visitors who stay for one meal and either classes or activities.

Scholarships: If you would like to attend but cannot afford the entire camp fee, scholarships of up to 50% may be provided in special cases. Requests for scholarships must be relieved by July 1, 2007

Early Registration is encouraged. Please return your completed Registration Form with 1/4 payment as early as possible. Registrations/Cancellations Postmarked after July 1, 2007: Registrations will be charged an additional fee of \$20. Cancellations will have \$20 withheld from the refund. Registrations received after July 15, 2007 will be accepted only as lodging arrangements permit. More information, regarding camp will be sent to those who register. The remaining portion of your registration fee is due upon your arrival at the camp.

Lodging Facilities

Campers age 9 (entering 4th grade) through age 19 (recently graduated High School) are encouraged to stay in cabins with other campers their age. Bedding needs to be provided by the camper. An adult counselor is assigned to each cabin.

Adults and Families may either stay in a cabin or may choose to stay in a Lodge Room. The lodge is air-conditioned and bedding is provided. Two of the upper floor rooms are handicap accessible. All upper rooms sleep six people and include private bathrooms. The lower level rooms sleep six to eight people with one double bed and the rest bunk beds. Bathrooms on the lower level are in a central location. **Lodge rooms are limited, and will be assigned on a first registered, first served basis, and cabins will be assigned thereafter.**
