Adult Program: Pastor David Hanson State College, Pennsylvania

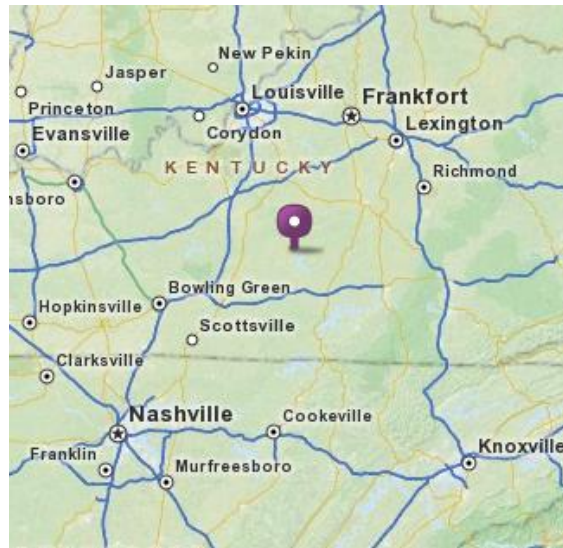
