High School Program: Pastor Jonathan Haney Manhattan, Kansas



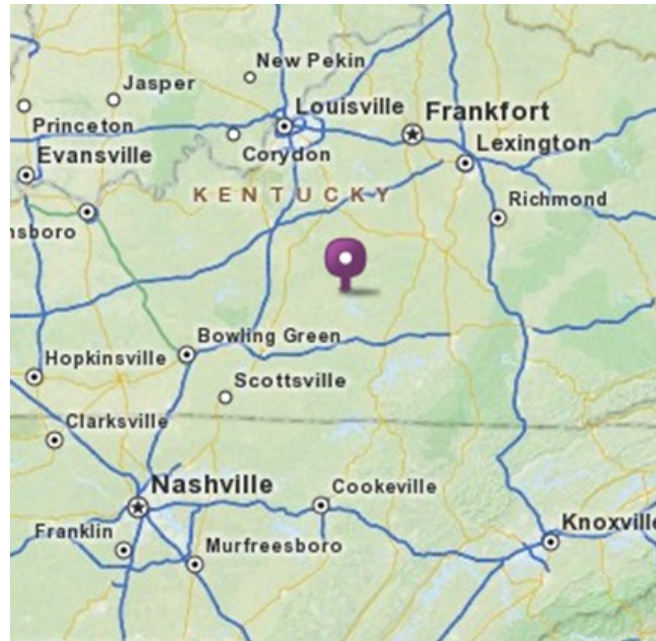
