High School Program: Rutledge Etheridge Geneva College, Pennsylvania



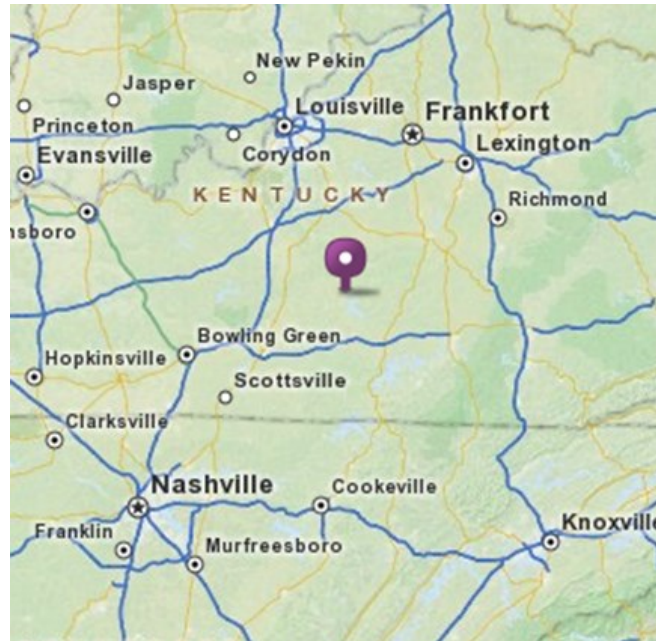
