

## DATES & TIMES

Camp begins at 6 pm, Friday, August 3 and ends at 9 am, Friday, August 10, 2018. Arrival and departure times are flexible and campers are welcome to register for part-time camp attendance at a reduced rate. Campers are free to arrive before 6 pm when dinner is served but cabin assignments for children are not available until after the registrar arrives at 5 pm.

## HOUSING OPTIONS

Children ages 7-17 can choose to stay in cabins based on age and gender for the duration of the week, with a counselor supervising them. Minors attending camp must still have an adult who is responsible for them also at the camp. Housing options vary for families and singles, and include a men's cabin, a women's cabin, family cabins (limited availability), RV parking, and tents. For more details, see the web site.

## SPEAKER

This year's speaker is Pastor Titus Martin of College Hill (Beaver Falls, Pa.) RPC. His topic is **“The Great Race”** and the theme verses are **1 Cor. 9:24-27**. The theme psalm is **119H**, “My Portion is the Lord.” Titus is a native of Phoenix, AZ, and a graduate of Geneva College and the Reformed Presbyterian Theological Seminary.

## ACTIVITIES

This year's activities theme is **“The Amazing Race”** (which coordinates with the speaker's topic of “The Great Race”). Campers will have opportunities to be in the air, on water, and on land during the week, including a **hot air balloon ride**, time at the lake, and a **campfire-time hayride** (a new activity this year that we hope to make a WL tradition!).

Family Camp is run by Director Bob Allmond, and by a young people's president, who plans activities. This year's president is Kayla Milroy. A team of Christian young people serve as counselors to supervise the youth.
