

DATES & TIMES

Camp begins at 6 pm, Friday, August 2 and ends at 9 am, Friday, August 9, 2019. Arrival and departure times are flexible and campers are welcome to register for part-time camp attendance at a reduced rate. Campers are free to arrive before 6 pm when dinner is served but cabin assignments for children are not available until after the registrar arrives at 5 pm.

HOUSING OPTIONS

Children ages 7-17 can choose to stay in cabins based on age and gender for the duration of the week, with a counselor supervising them, or stay with their parents. Minors attending camp must still have an adult who is responsible for them also at the camp. Housing options vary for families and singles, and include a men's cabin, a women's cabin, family cabins (limited availability), RV parking, and tents. For more details, see the web site.

THEME VERSES

“Do you not know that all of us who have been baptized into Christ Jesus were baptized into his death? We were buried therefore with him by baptism into death, in order that, just as Christ was raised from the dead by the glory of the Father, we too might walk in newness of life.

For if we have been united with him in a death like his, we shall certainly be united with him in a resurrection like his.
